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1. Policy Statement

- 1.1. Statement
- **1.1.1.** React quickly to a bomb threat.
- 2. Policy Objective
- 2.1. Objective
- **2.1.1.** React quickly to protect residents, visitors and employees.
- **2.1.2.** Get help quickly from emergency services.
- 3. Application of the policy
- 3.1. Application
- **3.1.1.** This policy applies to all employees of the Residence.
- 4. Policy requirements
- 4.1. Requirements
- **4.1.1.** When a bomb threat is received by phone, the person receiving the call tries to get as much information as possible according to the pamphlet located near the phones, while remaining calm.
- **4.1.2.** The person who receives the call gets the attention of another person in their life. The informed person takes the following steps:
 - a. Triggers the alarm.
 - **b.** Announces the black code followed by the green code stat.
 - **c.** Call 911
 - **d.** Notify the administrator.
- **4.1.3.** The Administrator or designate coordinates the evacuation response as set out in the evacuation plan and takes control until police and emergency services arrive.
- **4.1.4.** Personnel begin evacuation immediately as taught in evacuation practices.
- **4.1.5.** Emergency services take charge upon arrival. The police department makes decisions regarding the safety of residents, staff and visitors.



- **4.1.6.** The follow-up of the operations, with the families, will be done from the command post established by the emergency service.
- **4.1.7.** A designated person ensures that the incident is reported to the MOHLTC according to Policy and Procedure 760.06 and Appendices A, B, C and D.
- **4.1.8.** In the event that the Residence must evacuate for an indefinite period of time, the procedures in the Residence's evacuation plan are followed to ensure continuity of services to residents.
- **4.1.9.** This policy is tested once a year during the annual evacuation.

 - a. Become familiar with and comply with this policy.
